

Law Courses Renumbered for Fall 2008

As part of the new General Education program introduced for the Fall 2008 entering freshmen class, two courses in Law have been renamed and renumbered for Fall 2008. Most seats in these classes will be reserved for Fall 2008 entering freshmen

<i>Law</i>	0856 – Law & American Society	1001 – Law in Society	C001 – Law in Society
<i>Law</i>	0803 – African Americans, Equality, & Law	1002 – Racial Discrimination Under the Law	C050 - Racial Discrimination Under the Law

Note: Prior to Fall 2008, Law 1002 (C050) satisfied both *Studies in Race* **and** *American Culture* for the University Core Curriculum. Effective Fall 2008, this course will meet **only** *Studies in Race* for the University Core or Race & Diversity for the General Education curriculum. The General Education curriculum is required for freshmen entering Fall 2008 and after.
