Students covered by this agreement have received degrees from CCC approved for Core-to-Core transfer to Temple, and have therefore met all Temple Core Curriculum requirements except two Writing-Intensive courses to be taken at Temple (one of which is an upper-level capstone course in their major.) The above equivalents are provided for information only.

\*MTH 127 OR 140 are equivalent to second semester core mathematics courses at Temple University and each one will fulfill the Fox School of Business and Management core curriculum mathematics requirement.

\*\* It is strongly recommended that all CCC students, with the exception of Accounting majors, take SPE-102 and MTH-112 as their elective courses. The completion of these courses at CCC is necessary to insure the proper sequencing of course work at Temple. Not taking these courses at CCC may prevent the student from completing their degree at Temple in four regular semesters. Accounting majors should take ACC-214 & 216.

\*\*\* Temple University's BA 50 is waived for CCC students who transfer MGT – 101

Temple University's CIS 55 is waived for CCC students who transfer CSC – 101. Students will still need to take one Laboratory Science class.
