Students covered by this agreement have received degrees from CCP approved for Core-to-Core Transfer to Temple, and have therefore met all Temple Core Curriculum requirements except two Writing-Intensive courses to be taken at Temple (one of which is an upper-level capstone course in their major). The above equivalents are provided for information only.

* Math 1022 & 1041 are the preferred math courses for the Fox School of Business and CCP. You may also take Math 1101 and Math 1102 to fill this requirement.

** It is recommended that all CCP students complete the remaining business electives recommended by Temple after checking with a CCP counselor or advisor to determine if all CCP degree requirements are met.

*** It is strongly recommended that all CCP students take ECON 112, to fill one of their business electives. In addition, it is strongly recommended that all CCP students choose two of the following to fill their remaining business elective credits: MGMT 121, MGMT 141, MKTG 131, MGMT 142, FIN 151. The completion of these courses at CCP is necessary to insure the proper sequencing of course work at Temple. Not taking these courses at CCP may prevent the student from completing their degree at Temple in four regular semesters. Accounting majors should take ACCT 201 & 202

NOTE: Temple University's BA 0050 is no longer required at Fox. Students transferring MGMT 121 will receive elective credit

Temple University's CIS C055 is waived for CCP students who transfer MGMT 142.
