#### **PHILADELPHIA'S ENTREPRENEUR IDOL JUDGE**

As Executive Director of Campus Philly, Jon Herrmann has achieved success as an entrepreneur in the nonprofit sector. With support from the City of Philadelphia as well as government, higher education, and business partners, Campus Philly is changing what it means to be a college student in Greater Philadelphia. The organization and its partners have positioned Philadelphia to increasingly retain college graduates with programs to enroll, engage, and employ students regionally.

Following his graduation from The Wharton School at University of Pennsylvania in 2000, Herrmann soon after joined the Board of Directors for the West Philadelphia Cultural Alliance, which raised \$400,000 to restore the historic Paul Robeson House during his participation. He is now serving as an active member of the Philadelphia Children's Commission, as well as two advisory committees for Greater Philadelphia Tourism Marketing Corporation.

True to Campus Philly's mission, the Northern Jersey native has established permanent roots here, purchasing a home in West Philadelphia and supporting his wife's efforts in founding a Reconstructionist Jewish synagogue in the community.
